

Closing the PGC down to shooting was not something that we ever wanted to do, but the circumstances required that we must. As we open things back up, please know that we want all of our members to be safe, and this is our top priority. Please read through the safety protocols that we will follow as we safely open the club back up for outdoor usage.

The following standard precautionary practices should be observed for all shooting activities, including archery, on club property:

1. Practice social distancing between non household member shooters.
2. Wear a face covering/mask.
3. Use hand sanitizer.

In addition to the standard precautionary practices, when participating in group shooting activities (sporting clays, archery, or trap) the following precautions should be observed:

- Do not congregate in groups of more than 10 individuals when in the parking or staging areas.
- Keep shooting groups/squads to a maximum of 5 individuals. Non shooters will not be allowed to accompany any squad onto the course.
- At which time a squad is determined and prepared, they should immediately proceed to their first shooting station and wait there until starting time (as applicable). Once the squad has completed shooting on a station, they should promptly proceed to the next unattended station on their list.
- If keeping a score sheet, designate a single squad member to record scores and handle score sheet.
- Upon completion of the course, the score sheet/clip board for the squad shall be placed in a predesignated area and each shooter shall attach the proper payment amount to that clipboard. Please bring the correct dollar amount with you to avoid the necessity of making change. Payment method may vary depending on what you're shooting.
- All clays shooters must pick up their own hulls.
- Make every effort to minimize the amount of people touching the controller/remote.
- Additional disinfection protocols may be required with no advanced notice.
- In the event of a machine malfunction, report malfunction to a sporting clays committee member.
- For trap, the trap house is closed to shooters and only the person organizing shall be allowed inside.
- Archers must pull their own arrows and minimize touching targets.
- Failure to follow these guidelines may result in ejection from the premises.
- All procedures are subject to change without notice.

Please note that for the time being the club house (including restrooms) will remain closed.
